A Year of Growth and Impact

The year 2025 marked another important milestone for Tupendane Foundation and Initiatives (TUFOI). As we entered our fourth year of service, we remained committed to improving the lives of children and communities through education, health, environmental conservation, and sustainable development initiatives.

Thanks to the incredible support of our partners, donors, volunteers, and community members, TUFOI achieved meaningful progress and expanded its impact across multiple programs.

Education Support Program

Education remained at the heart of our mission in 2025. TUFOI expanded its sponsorship program at **Bethlehem Star Pre & Primary School**, supporting **116 vulnerable pupils** with school fees, transportation, uniforms, learning materials, accommodation, and welfare support.

Additional contributions include

- 300 chairs and dining tables
- Textbooks and exercise books
- Food supplies
- Washing and drying machine
- Two laptops and five iPads
- Musical instruments for student development



These investments created a more supportive and inspiring learning environment for children from underprivileged backgrounds.

Solar Power for a Better Learning Environment

In partnership with **Sopowerful (Netherlands)**, TUFOI successfully installed a modern solar power system at Bethlehem Star Pre & Primary School.

- Reliable electricity for classrooms and dormitories
- Water pumping support
- Lighting for evening studies
- Power for laundry, printing, and school operations

The project has contributed to improved academic performance and reduced electricity costs for the school.

Clean Water Access Through Borehole Construction

Access to clean and safe water became a reality for Bethlehem Star School and the surrounding community through the completion of a new borehole project.

This project significantly improved sanitation, hygiene, and daily living conditions within the school community.



Environmental Conservation Initiatives

TUFOI continued promoting environmental protection and biodiversity conservation in **Mukuru Village, Ngarenanyuki Ward**. Together with our partners, we:

- Raised and distributed 1,000 indigenous medicinal tree seedlings
- Conducted awareness activities on environmental conservation and traditional medicine

The initiative empowered both students and community members to become active stewards of the environment.
